KEGGED BEERS

LAGERS

Usually crisp, clean, and mild, these go especially well when followed by a cider drink.

Granville Island Lager 5.0%

A Vancouver mainstay since 1984, this one is light and malty with hints of grass and a hoppy bitterness.

Okanagan Springs 1516 5.0%

A Bavarian Lager so-named to celebrate the landmark 1516 Purity Law.

R&B Bohemian Lager 5.0%

A rhapsodic take on the style, these local boys done good are staunch supporters of the Van city craft beer scene.

Lighthouse Lager 5.1%

A classic BC lager, this has a bright, straw colour with a sweet malty-ness and full flavour.

"The Rail" is self-serve; go to any open bar to order and receive your drinks.

PALE ALES

Ale, along with bread, was an important source of nutrition in the Middle Ages - better have some more to keep your strength up.

Tree Cuthroat Pale Ale 5.0%

Jan Zeschky of The Province calls this "One of the most underrated beers in B.C."

Phillips Blue Buck 5.0%

A deep amber coloured beer, this has a crisp finish and a delicate hop aroma.

Central City Red Racer ESB 5.0%

Packed with hops from the North West and the UK. and Surrey's famously good water, this is Gary Lohin's take on the classic English bitter.

Russell Blood Alley ESB 5.5%

Named after a notorious cobblestone laneway in Gastown, this well-balanced beer has rich roasted malt flavours and 50 IBUs for a crisp bitter finish.

INDIA PALE ALES

IPA's are a style that originated in Britain in the 19th century, brought to its hoppy apex by Northwest brewers. India refers to the destination for the original brews, higher in alcohol and hops so as to survive the long voyage.

Driftwood Fat Tug IPA 7.0%

Clocking in at 80+ IBU, this Northwest Style IPA took beer of the year at the 2011 Canadian Brewing Awards.

Made with Okanagan apples and pears, and fermented with champagne yeast, this dry cider will make you (temporarily) forget about beer!

Howe Sound Rail Ale Nut Brown 5.0%

Practically named after the Railway Club (okay, not really) this beer won Silver at the 2009 Canadian Beer Awards.

R&B Raven Cream Ale 4.8%

This is a dark yet surprisingly light-bodied cream ale that manages to be both complex and accessible - a two-time World Beer Cup medalist.

SEASONALS/NEW

Often changing to reflect each new season, these beers are here for a good time, not a long time.

Howe Sound King Heffy Imperial Hefeweizen 7.7%

A refreshing, German-styled wheat beer with a distinctive banana and clove aroma (no, really, give it a sniff!).

STOUTS

The darkest of beers, these are made using highly roasted malts or barley and often have coffee or chocolate overtones.

Guinness Stout 4.2%

A popular Irish dry stout that originated in 1759, studies claim Guinness can be beneficial to the heart, with iron and antioxidant compounds - we'll drink to that!

One of a very few Certified Organic stouts in the world, what goes into their beer is grown on their own integrated farm, right down to the water drawn from their own well.
